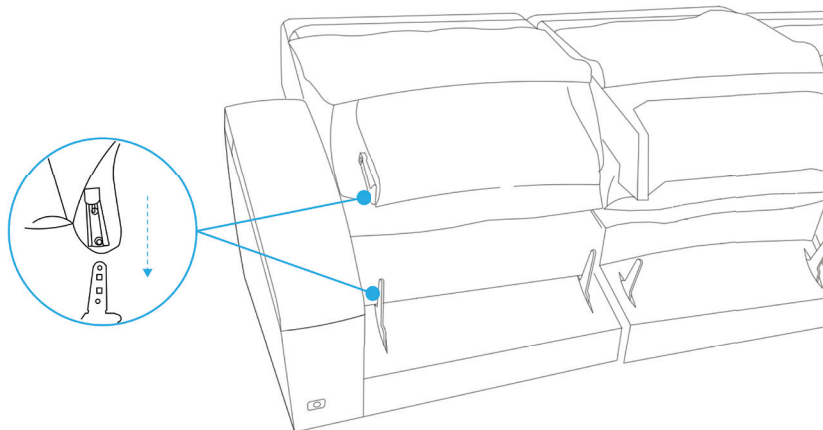

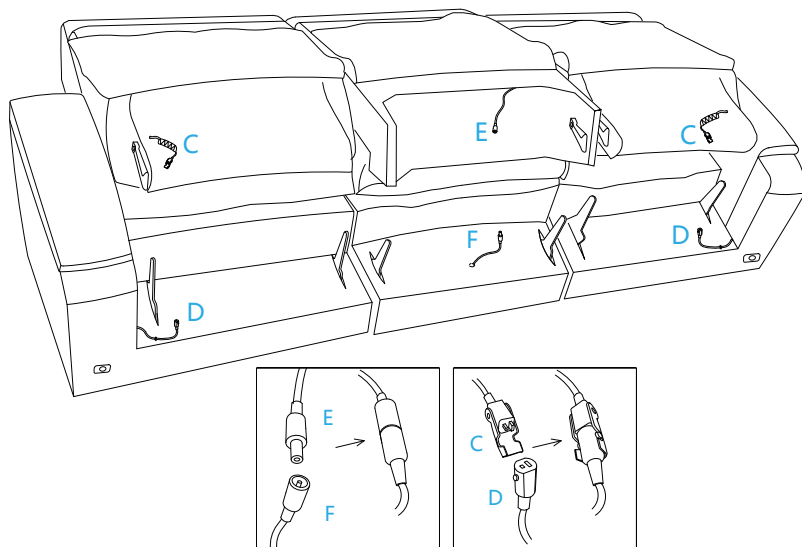

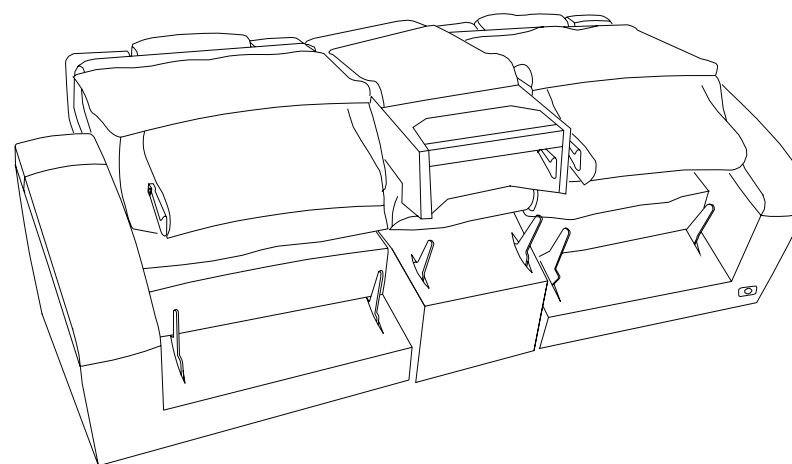

Step 2

Identify the backrests for the left-hand and right-hand side, plus the console - and place them facing down on the seat bases.



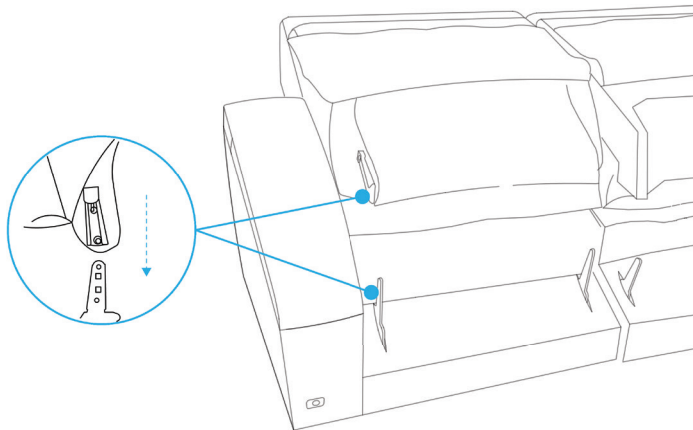
Step 3

Lift each backrest individually to align the metal receivers with the metal posts of the chair base. Allow the posts to slide into the receivers and press down firmly on the top of the backrest until a click is heard on each side.

Repeat also for the console.

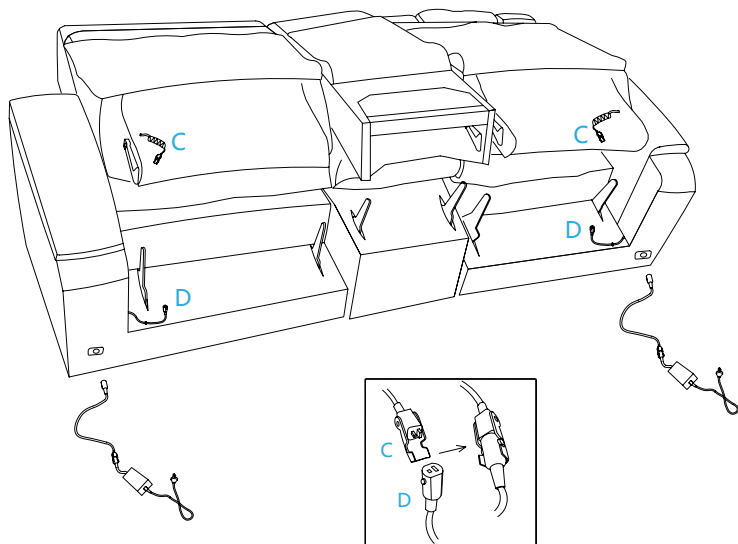

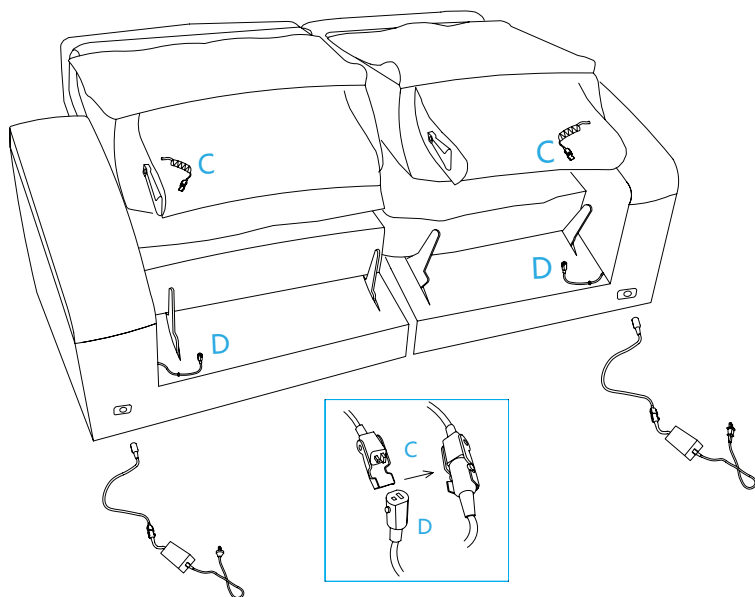

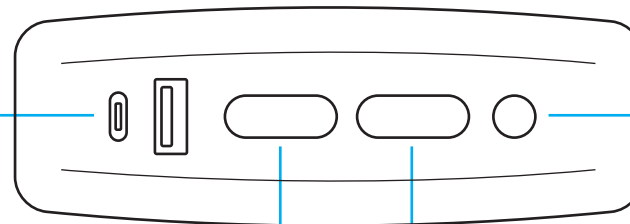

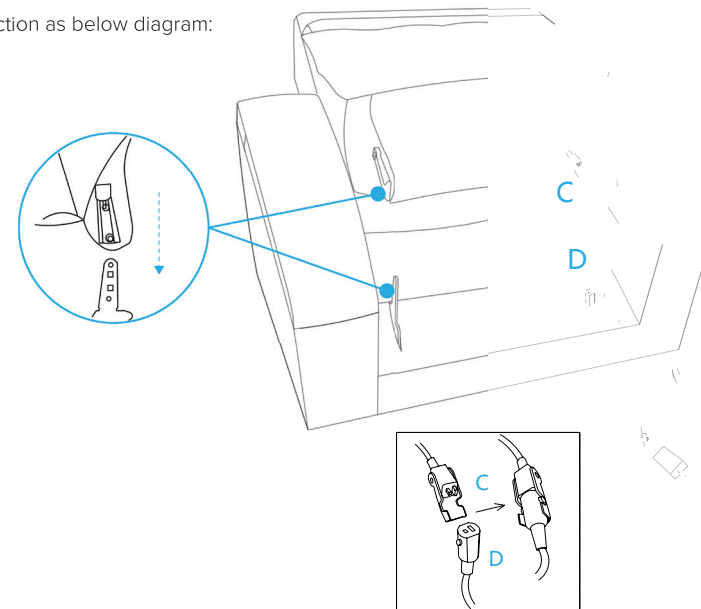
